

CERT Responding Personnel S.E.T.U.P.

S Stop

- breath in your nose out your mouth to de-stress a focus
- check for hazards
- look at patient and surrounding area for clues
 - 1. fall possible neck damage
 - 2. broken arm's or legs
 - 3. bleeding

E Environment

- Water, structure damage, etc

T Traffic

- Position your vehicle so that its acts as a protective wall for you
- Always check the passenger side of the vehicle to give additional room

U Unknown hazards

- Chemicals, electrical, etc.

P Patient

- Always protect yourself and the patient
- Wear protective gloves and mouth piece if needed
