

Campbell OES

The City of Campbell is part of a larger community prone to emergencies from winter storms to earthquakes. When an event strikes Campbell, the City can call for help from other agencies through the Santa Clara County Operational Area.

The Campbell Emergency Operations Center is a location from which the City coordinates its emergency response and is organized using the Standardized Emergency Management System (SEMS). The SEMS organizational structure consist of five principal Sections, which normally would be activated for major incident:

- Command Section
- Operations Section
- Planning Section
- Logistics Section
- Finance Section

The objectives of the Emergency Operations Center are to facilitate:

- Overall management and coordination of emergency operations.
- Coordination and liaison with appropriate federal, State, and other local government agencies and private sector resources.
- Management of mutual aid.
- Establishment of priorities.
- Collection, evaluation, and dissemination of damage information and other essential data.

County OES

The Santa Clara County Office of Emergency Services is responsible for coordinating organized planning efforts with County departments, local cities and special districts to mitigate against, prepare for, respond to, and recover from disasters. It is responsible for maintaining the County and Operational area Emergency Operations Centers in a continual state of readiness and for designing, conducting, and evaluating periodic emergency staff training and simulated disaster preparedness and response exercises.
